

Sample Decision Data and Flow Digest

Sample - synthetic data. This buyer-facing sample is synthetic and shows the shape of the files a customer can review after using ImpactLoop.

A delivery team used ImpactLoop after a sprint to separate one meaningful Done-review outlier from ordinary work, queue a stalled-review nudge, and publish a weekly digest back into Jira.

Honesty key

Category	What is in this sample
Synthetic data	All users, projects, spaces, filters, labels, Notion rows, issue keys, timestamps, and hashes are fictional.
Product shape	The files model a real ImpactLoop export surface: CSV rows, JSON audit context, manifest, and PDF narrative.
Boundary	This pack supports buyer evaluation. It is not legal advice, security attestation, or a substitute for customer-controlled audit testing.

What this pack proves

- Comments, nudges, and digest decisions can be reviewed with baseline context.
- Materiality thresholds explain why some completed issues receive no comment.
- The pack keeps action, delivery state, and skip reasons close to the Jira issue.

Limitations

- The sample uses fictional Jira issues, baselines, users, and digest content.
- ImpactLoop is an in-Jira follow-up layer, not a BI platform or warehouse.
- Baselines need enough issue history and correct phase mapping to be useful.
